

MT KAILASH - AN EXPEDITION



For travelers wishing to head into the Tibetan wilderness, venture over to the wild western outreaches for a trek of a lifetime around Mt Kailash. This mystical peak rising 6638 meters out of the Tibetan plateau is the source of some of the longest rivers in Asia. The Hindu God Shiva (destroyer of evil) is said to live on the summit in a state of perpetual meditation with his wife Pārvatī. The mountain has also been described as a lotus at the heart of six mountain ranges and played an important role in the incorporation of Buddhism into the native Bon beliefs. Followers of multiple religions believe that taking the Kora (pilgrimage route) around Mount Kalash will bring fortune. Enjoy the chance to trek with the numerous pilgrims who continue to take this grueling trail each year.
